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3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Kuljit Singh, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab-respondents No.1 to 3 only.

5. Learned State counsel submits that no representation has been received at the hands of the petitioners by the authorities in the State of Punjab and the representation dated 30.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) is addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sector 9-D, Chandigarh, for which, no action can be taken by the authorities of the State of Punjab. Learned State counsel further submits that in case any representation is received by the Punjab Police from the petitioners apprehending threat to their life and liberty, the concerned authority will take appropriate action within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation, on the representation of the petitioners so as to ensure the protection of their life and liberty in case the same is needed.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate application with the police authorities at Zirakpur.

7. Ordered accordingly.
