This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed praying for issuance of a writ, order or direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty and personal liberty of the petitioner by providing police protection with further prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to not harass the petitioner illegally at the behest of private respondents.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, in the light of assertions made in the petition, at this stage, I am of the view that calling upon the respondent No.2 would be suffice, who shall examining the representation dated 04.06.2024 (Annexure P/4) and decide the same within a stipulated period.



However, the learned State counsel points out that there is no proof coming forth qua the submission of the aforesaid representation in the instant petition as to whether it has been actually submitted or not by the petitioner to any of the authorities. Giving considerable thought to the aforesaid submissions by the learned State counsel at page No.27 of the paperbook, e-mail ID would reflect that the said representation was addressed to the Superintendent of Police, Rohtak, on 04.06.2024 at 04:29 p.m. at e-mail ID "sprohtak@hry.nic.in", and therefore, the aforesaid submission is of no avail to the State.

Hence, the Superintendent of Police, Rohtak, is directed to examine the representation dated 04.06.2024 (Annexure P/4), and to pass a speaking order within a period one week from the date of receiving the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law, after calling upon the petitioner and providing him due opportunity of hearing. A copy of such order, so passed by the Superintendent of Police, Rohtak, shall be communicated to the petitioner within next three days thereafter.

The instant petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
