Prayer in this application is for placing on record photographs
of ailing father of petitioner as Annexure P-5.

In view of the averments mentioned in the application, same is
allowed. Accompanied document i.e. photographs Annexure P-5 is taken
on record, subject to just exceptions.

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Petitioner – Nirmal Singh Gill has filed present criminal
miscellaneous petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking permission to go
abroad to see his ailing father, petitioner being involved in FIR No. 191
dated 19.10.2023 under Sections 458, 380, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC

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registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that father of petitioner is an old man who is not having good health condition. His condition is deteriorating day by day. Therefore, petitioner wanted to visit Canada to see his father in his last days. Petitioner has placed on record copies of letter as well as Passport Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively. It is further informed that during this period, father of petitioner namely Chamkaur Singh Gill has expired and now the petitioner is to attend his funeral. One downloaded copy regarding funeral of late Chamkaur Singh Gill is already placed on record. Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out that in the aforesaid FIR matter has been compromised and quashing of FIR is pending in the High Court bearing CRM-M No. 18690 of 2024 titled “Nirmal Singh Gill Versus State of Punjab and Another”. Copy of order dated 18.04.2024 is Annexure P-2.

3. Mr. Kuldeep Singh Saini, Advocate appeared on behalf of respondent No. 2 who has no objection to the present petition filed by petitioner seeking permission to go abroad to see his ailing father. Status report has been filed in which it is confirmed that in the aforesaid FIR petition for quashing of FIR has been filed.

4. I have considered the aforesaid factual position. Earlier present petition was filed seeking permission by the petitioner to go abroad to see his ailing father but unfortunately he has expired on 03.07.2024. Downloaded copy regarding funeral is also placed on record. Otherwise, matter has been compromised in the aforesaid FIR and quashing petition has been filed. Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 has given his no objection to this petition. Considering these facts, present petition filed by

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petitioner – Nirmal Singh Gill seeking permission to go abroad is allowed. He is permitted to go abroad (Canada) for a period of one month i.e. from 08.07.2024 till 07.08.2024, on furnishing of adequate personal as well as surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
