The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus*, directing respondents no. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and restrain the private respondents from interfering in their peaceful live-in relationship.

2. It is apparent on record that petitioner no.1 is married to respondent no.4, though staying in live-in relationship with petitioner no.2, who is working as a Head Constable in Haryana Police. He is also married having children.

3. The petition is bereft of particulars as to from whom and when any threat was received by the petitioners. It is also apparent on record that they are staying in live-in relationship for quite some time.

4. Considering the totality of facts and circumstances, no ground to entertain the present petition is made out.

5. Dismissed as such.
