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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition is for issuance of a writ, order or direction, especially in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents No. 5 and 6 (BDPO and Gram Panchayat Allanoor Nankpur, respectively) to deliver possession of Plot No. 3 to the petitioner.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for petitioner submits that as regards the grievance raised by the petitioner in the instant civil writ petition, he has also submitted a representation dated 02.05.2024 (Annexure P-7), addressed to respondent No. 2 (Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat, Haryana) and the petitioner would be satisfied if a time bound direction be issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation by passing a speaking order.
3. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No. 6 does not oppose the aforesaid course of action.

4. In view of above, the instant civil writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 (Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat, Haryana) to consider and decide the representation dated 02.05.2024 (Annexure P-7), submitted by the petitioner, within a period of four weeks from today, by passing a speaking order and after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

5. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stands closed.
