SANJAY VASHISTH, J.(ORAL)

1. On 06.12.2023, following order was passed:
- “Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he has not been able to file Power of Attorney on behalf of the petitioner as according to his information, petitioner-B.S. Prabhakar has expired. He seeks one last opportunity to move an appropriate application after getting instructions from legal heirs of the petitioner-B.S. Prabhakar for bringing on record the legal heirs.

At his request, adjourned to 14.02.2024.”
2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that despite making best efforts, no one has contacted her office and therefore she is not in a position to assist the Court.
3. This Court is left with no other option except to dispose of the petition in accordance with law.
4. Dismissed for want of prosecution.
5. However, it will be open to the petitioner/legal heirs to seek

revival of the present petition, if any, substantial cause of action or law requires its adjudication in the present petition subject to moving of an appropriate application within a period of 8 weeks from today.
