Application is allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions. Annexures P-5 to P-7 are taken on record.

Main case:

1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondent to supply the electric connection to the newly constructed 231 Advocates chambers built adjacent to the newly built District Court Complex, Hoshiarpur and not to insist on any oral demand for lump sum payment of Rs.35 lakhs to the contractor for the same.

2. Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.6 and 12 submits on behalf of respondent No.6 that the present petition has been rendered infructuous since the electric supply has already been released to the newly constructed chambers as prayed for and no other dispute survives.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to dispute the same.
4. In view of the aforesaid submission on behalf of respondent No.6, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
5. Liberty is however granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the petition in case the aforesaid statement is found to be factually wrong.
