The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the order dated 06.05.2024 (Annexure P-32) whereby the bail of the petitioner was cancelled and his bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State in case FIR No.84 dated 12.02.2017 under Section 15 (Act No.61) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at P.S. Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

On 12.06.2024 the following order was passed:-

“ *Learned Counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that after securing regular bail the petitioner has been regularly appearing before the trial Court on all dates but could not appear only on one date as he had noted a wrong date. He further submits that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the Trial Court on all future dates unless so specifically exempted.*

Notice of motion.



Mr. Dushyant Saharan, AAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and prays for time to argue the matter.

Adjourned to 2208.2024.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner shall appear before the Trial court within a week from today and on such appearance he shall be admitted to interim bail to the trial Court’s satisfaction.”

The Counsel for the petitioner submits that in deference to the aforementioned order the petitioner appeared before the Trial Court on 08.08.2024 and has since been admitted to interim bail and the case was adjourned to 14.08.2024.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and shall not absent himself without any sufficient cause.
