DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents as they are threatening the petitioner to withdraw the case/complaint filed by the peititoner against the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset prays for deciding the application/representation dated 20.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) expeditiously by passing a speaking order within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At this stage, Mr. Amit Kumar Goyal, Addl., A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and has no objection if appropriate directions are given for deciding the application/representation submitted by the petitioner.



Therefore, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala District Barnala to look into the grievances of the petitioner as set out in the petition and also expressed in the application/representation dated 20.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action for protection of life and liberty as may be warranted by the circumstances in accordance with law.

The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala District Barnala for requisite compliance.

The petition is disposed of.
