NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the practice of the respondents, whereby the respondents relieved the petitioners and subsequently re-appoint them on the post of Security Guard. Further seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to allow the petitioners to continue on the post of Security Guard and to decide the justice demand notice dated 04.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) served by the petitioners.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite his best efforts he has not been able to get further instructions from the petitioners as to whether any cause still survives in the present petition or not.
3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of for want of instructions. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the present petition, in case any cause still survives.
