[1] Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case RECR No.02 dated 20.05.2023 under Section 3 of Railway Property (Unlawful Possession) Act, 1966, registered at Police Station RPF Rewari, PP Narnaul.

[2] On 02.11.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

Mr. Sharmila Sharma, Sr. Panel Counsel for UOI.

It was wrongly mentioned on the last date of hearing that reply was filed on behalf of UOI. In fact, reply had been filed by way of affidavit of Shri Avtar Singh Tor, Assistant Security Commissioner, RPF, Rewari, District Rewari, on behalf of State of Haryana.

Today, a detailed reply by way of affidavit of Shri Avtar Singh Tor, Assistant Security Commissioner, RPF Rewari, District Rewari has been filed on behalf of respondent-UOI.

Adjourned to 09.01.2024.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting

Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

[3] Today, learned State Counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 02.11.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[4] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 02.11.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
