Present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 for providing protection of life and liberty and security to petitioners who are living together since 01.06.2024 in a live-in-relationship and not to interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioners at the behest of respondents No.4 to 7 and other relatives and friends.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the private respondents were adamant in getting the petitioner No.2 married with a boy of their own choice whereas the petitioner No.2 wanted to marry petitioner No.1 due to which she used to remain annoyed, irritated and frustrated and all the time used to think of petitioner No.1 and one day i.e. on 01.06.2024 she managed to escape from the shackles of private respondents and joined the company of petitioner No.1 and since then she is living with petitioner



No.1 in a live in relationship. Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that petitioners have submitted a representation (Annexures P-3) dated 06.06.2024 to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali and the same has not been decided till date. It is further contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners would be satisfied if the representation dated 06.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) is decided by the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Notice of motion restricted to respondent Nos. 1 to 3, only.

Mr. Amit Kumar Goyal, Addl. A.G. Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and has no objection if the present petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali to decide the representation dated 06.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali to decide the representation (Annexures P-3) of the petitioners after taking into consideration all the relevant aspects, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

Pending miscellaneous application(s) shall also stand disposed of.
