1. Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioners have sought the concession of anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.29 dated 21.05.2024, under Section(s) 61 and 78(2) of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at P.S. Tibber, District Gurdaspur.

2. After addressing arguments for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks leave to withdraw the instant petition, however, with liberty to the petitioners to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned and to make an application for bail before the latter, which may be directed to be decided expeditiously.

3. Leave granted.

4. Consequently, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn, however, with liberty to the petitioners to, within fifteen days from today, surrender before the learned trial Court concerned, and thereupon, if they make an application before the latter for grant of bail, the latter shall

decide the same, preferably within two days, but, after affording adequate opportunity of hearing to the opposite party.
