1. Through the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made for issuance of directions to the official respondents to release the petitioner on parole for a period of ten weeks, thus enabling him to get his old aged ailing mother treated.

2. This Court posed a specific query to learned counsel for the petitioner as to whether any application has been made by the petitioner to the authority concerned in respect to the claimed relief, to which he answered in affirmative and submitted that an application was duly moved to the authority concerned on 28.05.2024, which is yet pending consideration and no decision has been taken thereon so far.

4. Mr. Akshay Kumar, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and waives service.

5. Since an innocuous prayer has been made by learned counsel



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for the petitioner, therefore, without awaiting requisitioning any reply from the respondent-State, a direction is passed upon respondent No.4-Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar to, in case the petitioner has preferred any application, as alleged herein by learned counsel for the petitioner, the same shall be decided within 10 days and the order be also communicated to the petitioner.

With the observations made hereinabove, the instant petition is disposed of.
