MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking directions to the respondents to grant him emergency parole for 08 weeks for the treatment as well as for taking care of his father.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that no doubt the prayer of the petitioner for being extending the emergency parole had been declined but that was on account of the fact that at that point in time he was ineligible for the same. However, the petitioner, as per instructions received by the learned State counsel, has now become eligible and in case he moves a fresh application, the same would be decided by the authorities concerned in accordance with the relevant rules. Further, learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that there is a statement of the father of the petitioner wherein he has categorically stated that there was no serious medical ailment that

he was suffering from and he was in good health; furthermore, the petitioner is involved in a number of criminal cases.

3. In view of the instructions received by the learned State counsel, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he would not press the instant petition as he would now approach the authorities concerned. A prayer has, however, been made that the respondents be directed to decide his application for parole at the earliest.

4. In the circumstances, the instant petition is dismissed as not pressed. However, in case, and as and when, the petitioner moves an application seeking parole, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the respondents, in accordance with law.
