DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner as respondents No.4 to 6 shunted the petitioner from her matrimonial home and issuing threats to eliminate the petitioner as and when she is traced.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with respondent No.4 in the year 2008 and two children were born out from this wedlock. He further contends that in the year 2016, respondent No.4 left the company of the petitioner and started residing with some other lady at different place. He further contends that private respondents No.5 and 6 are persons of greedy nature and they always harassed and humiliated the petitioner on the petty issues by saying that she is an unlucky lady and just because of that her husband had left her. Learned



counsel also submits that petitioner has submitted a representation (Annexures P-1) dated 10.03.2024 to respondents No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali and respondent No.3-SHO Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali and the same has not been decided till date and petitioner would be satisfied if the representation dated 10.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) is ordered to be decided by the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

3. Notice of motion restricted to respondent Nos. 1 to 3, only.
4. Mr. Amit Kumar Goyal, Addl. A.G. Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and has no objection if the present petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali to decide the representation dated 10.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali to decide the representation dated 10.03.2024 (Annexures P-1) to look into the grievance of the petitioner as set out in the petition and take appropriate action for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner as may be warranted by the circumstances in accordance with law.
6. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali for requisite compliance.
