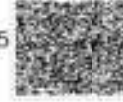

By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C,
the petitioner seek anticipatory bail in case FIR as under: -

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
264	12.09.2023	21 of NDPS Act (29 of NDPS Act added later on) (27-A of NDPS Act added vide zimni No. 13 dated 14.04.2024	Civil Line Batala, District Batala

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in
compliance to the order dated 14.06.2024, the petitioner has joined the
investigation.



3. During the course of hearing on 14.06.2024, following order has been passed: -

‘Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.264 dated 12.09.2023 registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act (Section 29 of NDPS added later on) and subsequently Section 27-A of NDPS Act added vide zimni No.13 dated 14.04.2024 at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, District Batala.

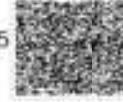
Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide order dated 09.10.2023 petitioner has already been granted regular bail by the trial Court. However, police added the offence under Section 27-A of NDPS Act vide zimni No.13 after about seven months. Further, recovery has already been effected from the petitioner which is of non-commercial quantity i.e. 04 grams of heroin along with Rs.35,000/- currency notes. He also submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required and he is ready to join investigation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amit Kumar Goyal, Addl. AG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 13.08.2024.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C’



4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jatinder Pal Singh, informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 14.06.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 14.06.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
