Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No. 39 dated 19.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 363, 366 and 120-B (later on added offences under Sections 376, 498 of IPC) at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga and further proceedings arising thereupon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that parties have amicable settled their dispute and their joint statement is annexed as Annexure P-8. The FIR(supra) is an outcome of the matrimonial dispute between Amrik Singh and Anju. Petitioner No.1 is the mother of Amrik Singh, petitioner No. 2 is brother of Amrik Singh and petitioner No. 3 is sister-in-law of Amrik Singh. During the pendency of present petition, unfortunately both Amrik Singh and Anju have passed away and even after the settlement, respondent No. 3 is not coming forward for quashing of the FIR(supra).



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In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to file a fresh petition seeking quashing of the FIR(supra) with aforesaid facts.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
