1. Through the instant petition, the petitioner craves for indulgence of this Court for his being enlarged on regular bail, in case FIR No.1155 of 20.12.2021, under Sections 363, 366A, 377, 506, 34, 120-B IPC, and Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, and Under Section 67 of Information Technology (Amendment) Act 2008, registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.
2. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by ASI Sajjan Singh, informs this Court that out of total 16 cited prosecution witnesses, in the final report, 15 have already been examined, and one remaining witness, which is to be examined on dated 21.03.2024 by the learned trial Court concerned.
3. In view of the above, the trial which is about to be concluded in a short span of time, no ground is made out for grant of regular bail.
