DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL

1. The petitioners have approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 for protection of their lives and personal liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 6.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that both the petitioners are major. In support thereof, copies of Aadhaar Cards pertaining to the petitioners have been appended. The learned counsel for petitioners further contends that they have performed marriage against the wishes of their parents. The marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 10.06.2024. Copy of Marriage Certificate (Annexure P-3) and copy of photographs of marriage (Annexure P-4) have also been appended.

3. After going through the contents of the representation, the same seems to be vague and half baked, wherein no specific details have been mentioned.



4. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present writ petition be treated as representation and the same be ordered to be decided within a time bound manner by looking into the grievance of the petitioners.

5. Therefore, without examining the question of legality and validity of the marriage and expressing any opinion thereon, the petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar, Punjab, to look into the grievance of the petitioners as set out in the petition and the same be treated as representation and take appropriate action for protection of their lives and liberty as may be warranted by the circumstances in accordance with law.

6. The petition is disposed of.
