1. This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of interim bail for one week in FIR No. 64 dated 27.02.2024 under Sections 34/379-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at P.S. Bhalgarh, Sonipat.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a student of M.Tech CSE (AIML) in M.D.U., Rohtak for session 2022-2024 and vide email dated 14.05.2024, he has been informed that he has to submit his dissertation and attend viva by 15.06.2024.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Learned State Counsel appearing on advance notice, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and has verified the facts mentioned in the petition.

Without adverting to merits of the case and considering that to pursue his studies further, the petitioner has to submit his dissertation and to attend viva, therefore, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim regular bail for a period of four days on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned. He is directed to surrender back to the Jail Superintendent concerned after expiry of four days i.e. on 16.06.2024 before 5:00 PM.
