HARKESH MANUJA, J.

The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeks grant of regular bail pending trial in case bearing FIR No.10, dated 07.02.2024, under Sections 323, 341, 325, 506, 148, 149 of IPC (Sections 201 & 307 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur, whereby the petitioner alongwith other co-accused

has been implicated with the allegations of having caused injuries on the person of complainant-Amritpal Singh with an intention to kill him.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for the past about 4 months and has been falsely implicated in the present case; thus, prayer is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

[3] On the other hand, learned State Counsel vehemently opposes the prayer made on behalf of the petitioner, while referring to the injuries inflicted upon the person of complainant besides the involvement of petitioner in one more case under IPC.
