By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
133	03.04.2024	420, 467, 469, 471 of IPC	Civil Lines, Sirsa, District Sirsa, Haryana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance to the order dated 15.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 15.07.2024.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajpal, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial investigation.
4. During the course of hearing on 15.07.2024, following order

was passed:



“ Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case on the basis of alleged disclosure statement made by co-accused Krishan. He further submits that even during the pendency of the bail application pending before learned Sessions Judge, Sirsa the petitioner had joined the investigation and is still ready to join and cooperate with the investigation.

2. The learned State counsel while referring to the reply submitted by the State has submitted that as per the reply the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. In view of this aspect, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation further within 7 days from today and to co-operate with the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

4. List on 08.08.2024. ”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 15.07.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 15.07.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.



- 6. The petition stands allowed.
- 7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
