1. The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 9, as they are continuously harassing and humiliating the petitioners by issuing threats to leave the village, otherwise, they will kill the petitioners because the private respondents want to grab the land of the petitioners.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, would submit that for their grievance, the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 06.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) to the Superintendent of

Police, District Sonipat i.e. respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. At this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied in case said representation is decided in a time bound manner.

3. Vide order dated 13.06.2024, notice of motion had already been issued to official respondents No.1 to 3. Learned State counsel submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioners. Today, appearance has also been caused by Mr. Rajesh Dhiman, Advocate, on behalf of respondents No.4 to 9 and filed *vakalatnama*, which is taken on record.

4. Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to the counsels appearing on behalf of the respondents during the course of day.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Sonipat, to decide the representation 06.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioners, in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
