By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.67 dated 02.02.2019 registered under Sections 166, 218, 420, 447, 465, 467, 467, 468 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Samalkha, Panipat.

The case is dependant upon the documentary evidence. Though the FIR was lodged wayback in February, 2019, the petitioner is sought to be arrested at this stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Status report has already been filed.

Learned State Counsel does not dispute the fact that case of the petitioner is dependant upon the documentary evidence.

In the afore-said facts and circumstances of the case, present petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail. Therefore, it is directed that in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the

petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
