NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the impugned order dated 25.05.2015 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2, order dated 24.11.2016 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.1 and resolution dated 20.03.2017 (Annexure P-7).
2. After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy of appeal/revision before the Competent Authority.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
4. However, it is made clear that if the petitioner file an appeal/revision within a period of 04 weeks from today, the same shall be considered and decided by the Competent Authority on merits.
