1. The petitioners have approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 for protecting their lives and personal liberty from respondent Nos.4 and 8.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that both the petitioners are major. In support thereof, copies of Aadhaar Cards pertaining to the petitioners have been appended. The marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 11.06.2024. Copy of Marriage Certificate is Annexure P-3 and copy of photographs of marriage is Annexure P-4, which have also been appended. The learned counsel for petitioners further contends that they have performed marriage against the wishes of their parents. The petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty and claim that there is a constant danger of being implicated in a false case. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that a representation dated 11.06.2024 (Annexure P-5) has also been sent by the petitioners to the respondent

No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Yamunanagar but the same has not been



decided till date and petitioners would be satisfied if the said representation is ordered to be decided in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Vipul Sherwal, AAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents Nos.1 to 3 and has no objection if appropriate directions are given for deciding the representation submitted by the petitioners.
5. Therefore, without examining the question of legality and validity of the marriage and expressing any opinion thereon, the petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Yamunanagar to look into the grievance of the petitioners as set out in the petition and also expressed in the representation (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action for protection of their lives and liberty as may be warranted by the circumstances in accordance with law.
6. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Yamunanagar for requisite compliance.
7. The petition is disposed of.
