This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for seeking parole of the petitioner under Section 3 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners Act for a period of six weeks in Sessions case No.121 of 2021 arising out of FIR No.33 dated 23.02.2019 under Section 10 of the POCSO Act and Sections 354, 452 and 506 IPC (challan filed under Sections 4, 18 of the POCSO Act and Sections 452, 506, 376 (3) and 511 of IPC) registered at Police Station, Sanoli District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is seeking parole on the ground that the wife of the petitioner is in family way and there is no other family member to look after her. In fact, the family consists of old age father who is suffering from paralysis and he cannot move. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is given to the competent authority to look into the matter and the representations dated 27.05.2024 (Annexure P5) and dated 27.05.2024 (Annexure P6) are decided in a time bound manner.

In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the competent authority concerned to look into the matter and to decide the representations dated 27.05.2024 (Annexures P5 & P6) within a period of 01 week from the receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law.
