JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 24.05.2012 (Annexure P-2) and direct the respondents to release his retiral dues.
2. Mr. T.K. Joshi, Advocate submits that petitioner has already retired and respondents as per their calculation has released retiral dues, nevertheless, if petitioner files his calculation, it would be considered and any amount, if found due, would be released.
3. Mr. J.C. Kapoor, Advocate submits that he would file his calculation within one week and respondents may be directed to complete calculation and release dues in a time bound manner.
4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition

stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to file his calculation. The respondent within four weeks from the date of receipt of calculation from petitioner would complete its exercise and release dues thereafter within two weeks, if any.
