Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5 as they are legally married.

Learned counsel for the petitioners refers to the order dated 27.05.2024 passed by respondent No.2, vide which concerned SHO was directed to look into the grievances of the petitioners and was also directed to ensure that any complaint/representation, if lodged by the petitioners shall be looked into immediately. The grievance raised through present petition is that inspite of order dated 27.05.2024, no such action has been taken by the police authorities, whereas respondent Nos.4 and 5 are still threatening the petitioners.

Learned State counsel was directed to have instructions with regard to the order dated 27.05.2024. He on instructions from SI Rai Singh

submits that in case a fresh representation with regard to giving protection to the petitioners is made, the same shall be considered expeditiously.

Faced with the above situation, learned counsel for the petitioners, keeping in view the threats being received at the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5, undertakes to file fresh representation within a period of three days.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 that in case petitioners file representation, on the subject mentioned above, the same shall be considered expeditiously and, if warranted, the appropriate action be taken for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
