1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.366 dated 25.05.2022 registered under Sections 323 and 506 of IPC (Section 354 of IPC deleted later on), at Police Station Sector 32-33, Karnal, District Karnal and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 02.03.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. This Court vide orders dated 14.06.2024 and thereafter vide order dated 18.10.2024 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid orders, parties have appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Karnal and got their statements recorded.

On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Judge has submitted a copy



of report dated 26.11.2024 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondents No.2 & 3 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.366 dated 25.05.2022 registered under Sections 323 and 506 of IPC (Section 354 of IPC deleted later on), at Police Station Sector 32-33, Karnal, District Karnal and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 02.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioner.
