1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 31.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) vide which the departmental proceedings have been initiated against the petitioner during the pendency of the FIR No. 152 dated 25.03.2017 registered under Sections 384 and 389 IPC.
