KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought the concession of anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.178, dated 30.05.2024, under Section 380 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Rewari City, District Rewari.
2. After addressing arguments for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant petition, however, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned and to make an application for bail before the latter, which may be directed to be decided most expeditiously.
3. Leave granted.

4. Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed as withdrawn**, however, with liberty to the petitioner, to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned, within fifteen days from today, and thereupon, if he makes an application before the latter for grant of bail, the latter shall decide the same, preferably within two days, but, after affording adequate opportunity of hearing to the parties concerned.
