- 1. The instant contempt appeal is directed against the impugned order, whereby the learned Contempt Court has issued a notice, upon the present appellant to show cause, as to why the present appellant be not convicted for allegedly committing contempt of Court.
- 2. Since in the impugned order only the above directions have been made, upon the present appellant/contemnor, therefore the mere issuance of a show cause notice, thus makes the instant contempt appeal to be not maintainable before this Court.
- 3. Accordingly the instant contempt appeal is dismissed, on the ground that the same is at this stage, thus completely mis-constituted and/or is premature.
- 4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand(s), disposed of.
