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As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company and counsel for the cross-objector-respondent Nos.1, 2, 5 and 6, (separately recorded today), a sum of Rs.90,00,000/- (Rupees Ninety Lakh only) more, over and above, the amount already received by the claimants/cross-objectors, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the cross-objector-respondent No.1, 2, 5 and 6, the enhanced amount would be paid to the cross-objector-respondent No.1-Rajwant Kaur.

Today, learned counsel for the appellant-Insurance Company, as per the instructions of Mr. Suryadeep Singh Thakur, Manager (Legal) ICICI Lombard Gen. Ins. Co. Ltd. and on the basis of settlement in cross-objection, wishes to withdraw the appeal filed by the Insurance Company.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

We dispose of the cross-objections filed by cross-objector-respondent No.1, 2, 5 and 6 with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.90,00,000/- (Rupees Ninety Lakh Only) in the name of the cross-objector-respondent No.1-Rajwant Kaur with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six week from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount

till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the appellant –Insurance Company. The counsel/respondents/cross-objectors may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.

The statutory amount of Rs.25,000/- deposited at the time of filing the appeal, be refunded to the Insurance Company, as per Rules.

Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.

Copy of the order be placed in the connected file.
