1. By way of present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, a prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.
2. The petitioners are present in Court besides, respondents No.4 and 5 (father & mother of petitioner No.1).
