Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already joined in pursuance to the impugned order of transfer but submits that as he is 75% handicapped, he be posted somewhere near to Zira and the petitioner intends to make an appropriate representation before the respondents and the respondents be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received at the hands of the petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file a representation.
