1. Prayer in this Criminal Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family from the hands of the private respondents. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent Nos.2 & 3 to decide representations dated 14.05.2024 (Annexure P-8 & P-9) moved by the petitioner.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot, District Faridkot, to consider and decide the representations dated 14.05.2024 (Annexures P-8 & P-9 marked to SHO, P.S. Sadar Kotkapura) submitted by the petitioner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Karunesh Kaushal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.
5. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of

the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed



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of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representations, as indicated above, are indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner and issue necessary directions accordingly.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
