Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to make the payment of Rs.17,67,806/- alongwith interest @ 12% p.a. from the date that the payment was due to the petitioner as per law for the completion of work of filling potholes and patch work of roads during rainy season at various locations in Ward No.7 in Division II, MCG, Gurugram.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has submitted various representations including the latest one dated 06.06.2024 (Annexure P-29) which was sent through email, but the respondents have neither paid the outstanding dues to the petitioner nor have they taken any action upon the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1; and Mr. Vivek Saini, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 to 6. They pray for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, contends that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.4- The Executive Engineer, Division-II, Municipal Corporation of Gurugram, C-1, Info City,



Sector 34, Gurugram is directed to treat the present writ petition as a representation and to consider and decide the same by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Learned Counsel for respondents No.2 to 6 has no objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.4 to treat the present writ petition as a representation and to consider and decide the same by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the said representation, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner within a further period of three months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
