1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent 1 to 3 to produce in person detenue Ravinder Kaur Kainth (wife of the petitioner), who has been illegally detained by respondent no. 4 to 6 at H.No.89, Patti Lakhi, Talwandi Mallian, Moga, Punjab, before this Court and set the detenue at liberty from their illegal confinement, in view of the facts and submissions made. It is further prayed that the warrant officer may kindly be appointed and respondents No.2 and 3 be directed to take action and to register FIR against respondent no.4 to 6 for forcibly confining the detenue/wife of the petitioner.

2. Notice was issued to the State and in pursuance to the same, ASI Baljit Singh and Constable Anu Rani, are present in Court alongwith the detenue. On the asking of the Court, the detenue has disclosed her name and age as Ravinder Kaur Kainth aged 31 years. On the asking of the Court, though she submits that she is married with the petitioner, however, she submits that she is living with her parents and wanted to remain with them.

3. In view of the statement made by the detenue, nothing survives

in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

4. The petitioner is at liberty to puruse his remedy in case any further cause of action accrues to him.
