Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.125 dated 21.04.2024, registered under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sector-65, District Gurugram.

Vide order dated 18.06.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 18.06.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from PSI Vinod Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant/respondent No.2 has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.



In view of the above, interim order dated 18.06.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
