1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for modification of award dated 16.07.2014 (Annexure P-1), passed by Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court-I, Gurgaon.
2. A perusal of the order sheets would reveal that the matter was adjourned sine die on 12.03.2018.
3. It appears that thereafter no effort was made on behalf of the petitioner to get the matter listed and the case was listed by DRR Section in motion hearing and on 18.10.2023, the following order was passed :-
