SUDEEPTI SHARMA.J. (ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition, as filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents No. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is 44 years old widow and tenant of private respondents No. 4 to 9, who are the landlord of the petitioner. He further contends that even FIR No. 81 dated 19.03.2024 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 379 IPC has been registered at Police Station Tehsil Camp, District Panipat against the landlords.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has also made a representation dated 06.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the

Superintendent of Police, District Panipat and he would be satisfied if the same is decided.

- 4. Notice of motion to the official respondent(s) only.
- 5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ayuwan, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
- 6. Without calling for any reply and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 - Superintendent of Police, District Panipat, to look into the representation dated 06.06.2024 (Annexure P-3), if it has been received by the office of the Superintendent of Police, District Panipat, and do the needful in accordance with law.
- 7. Disposed of accordingly.
