GURBIR SINGH, J. (Oral)

1. This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.201, dated 19.05.2024, under Section 15 of NDPS Act, 1985 (Section 27-A of NDPS Act added lateron) registered at Police Station Sadar, Fatehabad.
2. Vide order dated 19.06.2024, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Chiman Lal, submits that in compliance of order dated 19.06.2024, petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.
4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the order dated 19.06.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

6. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
