VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents no.2 and 3 for protecting the life and personal liberty of the petitioner and also directing private respondents no.4 to 6 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is major as the petitioner was born on 10.07.1994 as is apparent from her Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1). It is further submitted that the petitioner has given a representation dated 06.06.2024 (Annexure P-2) to respondent no.2 and would be satisfied in case the said representation is considered and decided by respondent no.2 in a time bound manner.



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3. Notice of motion to respondent nos.1 to 3 only.
4. On advance notice, Mr.N.S. Diwana, Sr.DAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent nos.1 to 3 and on a specific query put by this Court, he has stated that he has no objection in case, respondent no.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, looks into the representation dated 06.06.2024 (Annexure P-2) and takes appropriate action, in accordance with law.
5. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to consider and decide the representation dated 06.06.2024 (Annexure P-2) within a period of four weeks from the date of the receipt of the certified copy of the present order and after considering the threat perception to the petitioner, respondent no.2 will take appropriate action in accordance with law.
