1. By this common order CWP-16463-2015 and CWP-18244-2015 are disposed of as issue involved in both the petitions is common. For the sake of convenience, the facts are borrowed from CWP-16463-2015.

2. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 24.03.2015 (Annexure P-6) whereby respondent No. 4 has revised date of promotion of the petitioner from 07.03.1994 to 10.02.2000.
3. Mr. Pawan Kumar, DAG, pointing out affidavit dated 16.11.2022 of Superintendent of Police, Head Quarter, Sangrur submits that seniority list has been further revised and as per revised list, the petitioners have been granted rank of Head Constable w.e.f. 02.07.1994, thus, the present petitions have rendered infructuous.
4. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner expressed his inability to controvert aforesaid averment of the learned State counsel.
5. In view of statement of learned State counsel, the present petitions are disposed of as infructuous.
