AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Joga Singh has filed criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect life and personal liberty of petitioner by providing security cover since he is receiving death threats from private respondent No. 4 and other unknown persons over phone calls who are demanding ransom.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out that he had filed his representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), Annexure P-6, which has not been disposed of.

3. Learned counsel representing the State on instructions from ASI Gurjit Singh, No. 1878/ASR/R, P.S. Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar (Rural) stated that personal security is provided and that official is still with the petitioner. Whereas, this fact is denied by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. I have considered the aforesaid facts. Respondents No. 2 and 3 are directed to dispose of the representation dated 13.06.2024, Annexure

P-6 within one week and after considering threat perception to the petitioner, adequate steps may be taken.

With this direction, present petition is accordingly disposed of.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
