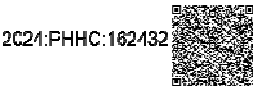

AMARJOT BHATTI, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioner Jaswinder Singh has filed petition under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus with the direction to official respondent for restraining respondents No. 4 and 5 alongwith their associates for taking forcible possession of land belonging to petitioner or further directing respondent No. 2 to take action on representation dated 27.05.2024 (Annexure P-2).
2. Perusal of file shows that petitioner Jaswinder Singh has already filed suit for permanent injunction against Bikramjit Singh and Gurjot Kaur. Copy of plaint is Annexure P-1 and matter is still pending.
3. Today, learned counsel for petitioner states that matter is also pending before SDM, Ludhiana.
4. At this stage, in pursuance of status report already filed in this case, learned counsel for petitioner wishes to withdraw present petition, with liberty to take all the defences available to him before appropriate authority.



5. In view of aforesaid statement, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, with aforesaid liberty.
6. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
