Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.14 dated 29.05.2024, under Sections 406, 380, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 of IPC registered at Police Station N.R.I. (Rural) Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 20.06.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation and the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for an amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the parties have submitted that the parties have settled the matter amicably before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 20.06.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He has also submitted that payment has already been made to the complainant which has been affirmed by learned counsel for the complainant.



Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Devinder Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

The report of the Mediator is also placed on record, affirming the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner that the dispute between the parties is resolved.

In view of the above, interim order dated 20.06.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
