ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

1. Sumanpreet Kaur and Jagjeet Singh, the petitioners before this Court, claim themselves to be major. It has been pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 7 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No. 4 to 7. They have placed on record the marriage certificate dated 11.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 11.06.2024, (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2.

2. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, this Court disposes of the writ petition with directions to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-5) within a period of one month and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear



that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

3. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any are also disposed of.
